**1. Regenerative Endodontics - Real Science or do we Believe in an Endodontic Genie?**

The speaker will outline his treatment philosophy for the management of young traumatised permanent teeth which have become non vital before the root development is completed. He will review the use of Mineral Tri-oxide Aggregate and explore the use of whether Regenerative Endodontics should be used as a treatment mode in these teeth.

**2. Trauma, Tears and Transplants - The Journey of a Child Through Complex Trauma with a True Interdisciplinary Approach.**

Paediatric Dentists are in a privileged position of treating young patients who are in a period of growth and development. Inter and multidisciplinary team efforts for the treatment of young children and adolescents with developmental defects resulting in pulp necrosis at an early age and those who are unfortunate to suffer severe dento-alveolar trauma, will ensure good long term outcomes for the patients. Ankylosed and infra-occluded teeth after trauma pose a serious management issue for clinicians with very serious implications for the child. Infra-occluding teeth can have disastrous consequences for the patient in the long term due to lack of alveolar bone growth in that region. Bone management is complex. Methods for conserving bone in region of ankyloses and autotransplantation will be discussed. This talk will aim to provide an overview of the protocols and outcomes of autotransplantation for replacement of anterior teeth and discuss the technique of

transplantation and subsequent endodontic management where teeth are lost as a result of trauma. The versatility of autotransplantation will be discussed as it can be used for numerous indications, including trauma, replacement of dilacerated teeth, developmental anomalies, replacing developmentally missing teeth etc.

**About the Presenter:**

Professor Monty Duggal obtained his dental degree and MDS in Paediatric Dentistry from India. He then immigrated to the United Kingdom and obtained his FDSRCS from the Royal College of Surgeons of England and his PhD from University of Leeds. He was appointed Professor and Chair of Child Dental Health at Leeds Dental Institute in 1999 where he oversaw a large postgraduate programme in Paediatric Dentistry which has international acclaim. In January 2017 he was appointed as Professor in Faculty of Dentistry, National University of Singapore. Professor Duggal has published over 130 research papers in international journals and is author of "Restorative Techniques in Paediatric Dentistry, which has been published in 7 languages and has sold over 16,000 copies worldwide. He is also a co-author of a textbook on Dental Traumatology and has co-edited "Paediatric Dentistry" by Oxford, now in its 4th edition, and more recently "Paediatric Dentistry at a Glance", published by Blackwell Willey. When not working Monty's main interest is playing and watching cricket and any time spare from work and family is devoted to this important activity.
